

Tennis Courts Regulations

General Usage

- Tennis shoes are MANDATORY, no other footwear is acceptable. Wearing of proper tennis apparel is encouraged.
- Court use is limited to residents and guests (tennis players). GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE RESIDENT. Anyone may question players as to their Greenwood residency. Players are required to carry their Greenwood Activity Pass to the court. The Greenwood security guard will periodically check players for their activity passes.
- Prohibited on the courts are:
 - Smoking, eating, or drinking.
 - Animals or pets of any kind.
 - Activities other than tennis, i.e., rollerblading, volleyball, etc.
 - Radios, television, or other audio equipment.
- Any person or persons willfully causing or creating any destruction of tennis facilities will be held responsible for the damages and will not be permitted to play again until the damages are repaired. Please report damage/culprits to security guard or GVCA Office.
- Court area is limited to TENNIS PLAYERS ONLY. Children and spectators are to remain outside the fence. No more than 4 players per court at any time.
- Children under 18, unaccompanied on the court by an adult resident, are NOT PERMITTED to play if adults are waiting to play during the following times:
AFTER 6:00 P.M. – MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, OR DURING SATURDAY, SUNDAY, AND HOLIDAYS
- Reservations:
 - A new schedule will be posted by 6:00 P.M. each Thursday.
 - No reservations are permitted during “special” hours. “SPECIAL” hours are Saturday and Sunday, 8:00 A.M. – 1:00 P.M. on the WEST COURT. At the discretion of GVCA Board, courts may be reserved for a limited period during weekdays for children’s lessons.
 - EACH HOUSEHOLD is limited to only one hour Monday through Friday, after 6:00 P.M., and only one hour either Saturday or Sunday. At no time can a household sign up for 2 consecutive hours.
 - Your Greenwood Activity Pass Number must accompany your name when making reservations or your name may be removed.
 - If there is a line to sign up, no person may sign up for a second household. (If signing for a second household, you must start at the end of the waiting line).
 - Any abuse of sign up regulations will result in FORFEITURE OF PLAYING PRIVILEGES. Those residents who observe violations should report them to security guard or GVCA Manager.
 - Reserved court time is forfeited if players are more than 10 minutes late.
 - A total of three NO SHOWS will result in loss of sign up privileges.
 - Unreserved courts are available on a first come, first serve basis. Playing time shall be limited to one hour if others are waiting.
 - In keeping with tennis etiquette, shouting and extensive loud talking are discouraged.
