Marshall Lake Update

Work is progressing nicely on the Marshall Lake dam restoration project. Koontz Construction completed the new concrete wall, which will prevent shoreline erosion.

Next steps: Seal any leakage holes behind the wall, reshape the shore to taper to the wall, fill low spots in the dam face, and install gravel to prevent animals from digging new holes in the shore bank.

It has been an interesting project, as two old spillways were discovered buried inside the dam. Each was the cause of leaks we had been unable to

plug. Now we know why. The leaks were hidden inside the 60' steel culvert spillway (already taken out and dam rebuilt) and





beneath the concrete spillway (which has been excavated and will soon be removed and dam rebuilt).

<u>Survey Update</u> The survey of the common property between Stoney Brook and Meadow Creek roads, including installation of GVCA property markers, is underway and should be finished in October.

Deep End Swim Test

- Anyone who wishes to swim in the deep end may be required by the lifeguard to first perform a swim test.
- The test includes swimming the length of the pool twice using any an aggressive front stroke with face in the water for one length of the pool and any stroke (not the dog paddle) for the second length of the pool, and treading water. Those who pass the test are recorded in our swim test log and permitted to swim in the deep end.
- To ensure every swimmer's safety, we start a new swim test logbook at least twice a year, so please don't be surprised if you are required to take the same swim test again. Safety is our first priority.

GVCA Semi-Annual Fee Was Due by July 30*

The bill for the July 2015 semi-annual fee of **\$212** was due July 30. You can mail your check or drop it through the slot in the office door. Alternatively, you can pay the semi-annual fee through your online banking program at your financial institution. Payee = GVCA, 830 Village Club Drive, Sagamore Hills, OH 44067. Include your GVCA account number, so your account is properly credited.

(*This is not an optional fee. Also note: There is a \$75 transfer fee on units bought in Greenwood, payable by buyer.) Last day to pay the fee without penalty was July 30, 2015, after which time we add a late fee of \$40 to all unpaid accounts. An additional late fee of \$20 is added to all unpaid accounts, including unpaid late fees, at the end of each month thereafter. After Sept. 30, all unpaid accounts are turned over to the attorney for collection, who places liens on the properties. All legal fees (such as \$75 for each legal notice sent, and \$250 to place and remove the lien) and court costs are the responsibility of owner and will be added to amount you owe. In addition, use of the facilities will be denied until account is paid in full.

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<u>ACCES</u>

<u>A Friendly Reminder</u>

Please remember **all changes**, improvements, additions, landscaping, etc., to the outside of an existing home or condominium unit **must have ACCES approval** <u>before the project starts</u>.

ACCES APPROVAL

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form. Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. You should have the latest ACCES Rules, dated 4/20/2004, which includes a list of items that do not need approval, as well as a list of what to include with the form, such as a design drawing, a plat map showing location, and color samples. <u>Single-family homeowners</u> must have their neighbors' signatures on the form. <u>Condominium owners</u> must have the written approval of their board or management company on the "Request for ACCES Approval" form <u>before</u> submission to the ACCES. <u>Condominium associations or</u> <u>their management companies</u> also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have it approved before beginning any outside projects. <u>All requests for approval should be submitted to the</u> <u>GVCA office two weeks prior to the meeting</u>.

The ACCES meets on the **first Tuesday of the month**. **The next** <u>ACCES</u> <u>submittal deadline is Tuesday, October 27, 2015</u>. This gives the committee members time to review and do an on-site inspection if necessary. The next ACCES meeting is on **Tuesday, November 3, 2015**, at 7:00 pm. Approval forms are available on the desk by the women's locker room. If you need a copy, contact the GVCA office or download it from the website. <u>Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning and Summit</u> <u>County building permits for your project!!!</u> Call the Zoning Inspector for Sagamore Hills Township (330-467-0900).

Retractable Awnings - Know the Rules

A retractable awning for any housing unit in Greenwood (single family home or condominium) requires ACCES Approval. [Homeowners need their neighbors' approval prior to submission to ACCES. Condo owners need their Association's approval prior to submission to ACCES.] The ACCES rules and standards for awnings are very exacting. ACCES recommends you read the retractable awning rules carefully prior to shopping to insure the one you select can meet GVCA's rigorous standards (show the supplier the standards). Owners will need a proposal from a supplier to submit with your retractable awning Request for Approval form and other supporting / information / materials. Only a few manufacturers meet the strict standards enacted by the GVCA Board of Trustees. For info go to: http://greenwoodohio.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/04/Retractable_-Awnings_Rules.pdf

Satellite Antennas

Satellite antennas, like all changes to your property, are covered by ACCES. If you wish to install a satellite antenna, call the GVCA office and the manager will come out and help you locate the best place to mount your antenna and will give you an instant ACCES approval. Note: the GVCA Board of Trustees passed a motion in 2001 prohibiting mounting individual satellite antennas on any GVCA or condominium common property, including buildings. Satellite antennas can only be mounted in your exclusive use area, which for condo owners is inside your patio or deck. (Pick up a copy of the ACCES guidelines on satellites from the website or the GVCA Office. Each condominium association is different, so please check with yours for their special rules regarding satellite or cable installation.)

Days Are Getting Shorter

Trash Can Storage

With the start of the new trash service for single family homes, we wanted to remind everyone that, except on trash day, all trash containers must be stored out-of-sight, which means inside your garage, or behind an ACCES approved screen*.

Recycling

Sagamore Hills has closed their recycling center and the private trash service at the Clubhouse does not accept recyclables. Single family homeowners can recycle with their new trash service. Please read the instructions Kimble provided, or go to http://www.mysagamorehills.com/curbside-recycle-reminder/ Condominium trash service is contracted by their association, not Sagamore Hills. Condo owners can recycle if it is part of their trash contract. Fire Safety

Please be safe when you cook outside! **DO NOT USE** your grill* within 10 feet of your house, car, deck, garage, or anything else combustible.

"In accordance with the Ohio Fire Code, charcoal burners, gas grills or any other type of open-flame devices* are prohibited to be used within (10) feet of a multi-family building (including the attached garage). The Ohio Fire Code also prohibits operation of such devices on balconies and decks. Violations of this Fire Code should be reported to the local Fire Department at the non-emergency phone number of 330-467-7410."

*Includes Tiki Torches, Candles, Chimineas, Kerosene Heaters, or anything else that burns!

NOTICE: Be sure your realtor knows Greenwood bylaws do not allow posting of unapproved signs. One 11 x 14 inch "For Sale" sign is permitted in the window. Contact the GVCA office if you are having an open house. The GVCA Board has approved Greenwood "Open House" signs that you or your realtor may rent at the office for no charge. (\$40 deposit required per sign).

Shopping for a Condominium?

Condominiums associations are required to be fully funded, unless the majority of residents vote against it every year. Fully funded associations typically have higher monthly fees, but should not hit you with special assessments for expected repairs. Check if your association is fully funded before you buy.

Thinking of Buying?
