
#### Greenwood Events

### <u>ACCES</u>

### <u>A Friendly Reminder</u>

Please remember **all changes**, improvements, additions, landscaping, etc., to the outside of an existing home or condominium unit **must have ACCES approval** <u>before the project starts</u>.

### <u> Trash Can Storage</u>

We want to remind everyone that, except on trash day, all trash containers must be stored out-of-sight, which means inside your garage, or behind an ACCES approved screen.

#### Satellite Antennas

Satellite antennas, like all changes to your property, are covered by ACCES. If you wish to install a satellite antenna, call the GVCA office and the manager will come out and help you locate the best place to mount your antenna and will give you an instant ACCES approval. Note: the GVCA Board of Trustees passed a motion in 2001 prohibiting mounting individual satellite antennas on any GVCA or condominium common property, including buildings. Satellite antennas can only be mounted in your exclusive use area, which for condo owners is inside your patio or deck. (Pick up a copy of the ACCES guidelines on satellites from the website or the GVCA Office. Each condominium association is different, so please check with yours for their special rules regarding satellite or cable installation.)

#### ACCES APPROVAL

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form. Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. You should have the latest ACCES Rules, dated 4/20/2004, which includes a list of items that do not need approval, as well as a list of what to include with the form, such as a design drawing, a plat map showing location, and color samples. <u>Single-family homeowners</u> must have their neighbors' signatures on the form. <u>Condominium owners</u> must have the written approval of their board or management company on the "Request for ACCES Approval" form <u>before</u> submission to the ACCES. <u>Condominium associations or</u> <u>their management companies</u> also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have it approved before beginning any outside projects. <u>All requests for approval should be submitted to the</u> <u>GVCA office two weeks prior to the meeting</u>.

The ACCES meets on the **first Tuesday of the month**. **The next** <u>ACCES</u> <u>submittal deadline is Tuesday, March 29m 2016</u>. This gives the committee members time to review and do an on-site inspection if necessary. The next ACCES meeting is on **Tuesday, April 5, 2016**, at 7:00 pm. Approval forms are available on the desk by the women's locker room. If you need a copy, contact the GVCA office or download it from the website. <u>Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning and Summit County</u> <u>building permits for your project!!!</u> Call the Zoning Inspector for Sagamore Hills Township (330-467-0900).

#### Dog License Reminder

Ohio law requires all dogs be licensed. Licenses are to be purchased by January 31 every year, or within thirty days if you acquire a new dog. Puppies must be licensed by the time they reach three months of age. Cost is \$18 annually for a one-year dog license, \$54 for a three-year dog license, and \$180 for lifetime/permanent dog license. Ohio law requires an additional late fee (\$18 in Summit County) if you did not renew your dog's license by January 31. You can buy it online at the county website: https://fiscaloffice.summitoh.net/index.php/dog-licensing or go to the License Bureau in Northfield Village.

#### Coyote Reminder

Coyotes are normally very shy. February was mating season, so now, and when the pups are born in April, is when they are most protective.

(Aggressive towards dogs!)

Please always keep your dogs leashed and don't leave them outside to keep them safe.



**Caution Cat Owners:** In Chicago, cats make up 7% of the coyotes' diet! Don't leave your cat out at night!

#### **Sign Rules**

NOTICE: Be sure your realtor knows Greenwood bylaws do not allow posting of unapproved signs. One 11 x 14 inch "For Sale" sign is permitted in the window. Contact the GVCA office if you are having an open house. The GVCA Board has approved Greenwood "Open House" signs that you or your realtor may rent at the office for no charge. (\$40 deposit required per sign).

#### Thinking of Buying?

Greenwood Village is one of the most unique developments in Ohio. Surrounded by parks, it is a nature lover's paradise. All residents are members of GVCA, which entitles you to use the amenities, such as swimming year-round at our indoor and outdoor pools, fishing in our pond stocked with rainbow trout, bass, bluegill, and channel catfish, playing tennis or volleyball on our outdoor courts, hiking on our trails, and rental of our party rooms. Be sure your title agency notifies GVCA of your pending purchase, so we can let them know about any GVCA fees they need to settle as part of the closing costs. Once you move in, please stop by the GVCA office at the clubhouse to sign up for your activity passes, so you can use the facilities.

### **GREENWOOD NEWS (Continued)**

#### GVCA Semi-Annual Fee was due January 30\*

The bill for the January 2016 semi-annual fee of \$212 went out in December and was due by January 30, 2016. You can mail your check or drop it through the slot in the office door. Alternatively, you can pay the semi-annual fee through your online banking program at your financial institution. Payee = GVCA, 830 Village Club Drive, Sagamore Hills, OH 44067. Include your GVCA account number on your check, so your account is properly credited.

(\*This is not an optional fee. Also note: There is a \$75 transfer fee on units bought in Greenwood, payable by buyer. (See Transfer Fee Increase notice.) <u>Last day to pay the fee without penalty was</u> <u>January 30, 2016</u>, after which time we add a late fee of \$40 to all unpaid accounts. In addition, use of the facilities will be denied until account is paid in full. An additional late fee of \$20 is added to all unpaid accounts, including unpaid late fees, at the end of each month thereafter.

After March 30, all unpaid accounts are turned over to the attorney for collection, who places liens on the properties. All legal fees (such as \$75 for each legal notice sent, and \$250 to place and remove the lien) and court costs are the responsibility of owner and will be added to amount you owe.


### A WALK IN MARCH

(\*We will send out an e-mail notice to let you know when we are delivering the trees.)

<u>For Flowering</u>, choose Redbuds, White Flowering Dogwoods, Sweet Shrub or Buttonbush. <u>For Edible</u>, choose Persimmon, Pawpaw, Maple (syrup), Hazelnut, Walnut, or Hickory. For Nuts/Wildlife, choose Oak, Hazelnut, Walnut, or Hickory.

For Wet Areas, choose Buttonbush, Bald Cypress, or White Cedar.

Pollinator Favorites, choose Buttonbush, Basswood, or Redbud.

For Evergreens, we recommend the Norway Spruce. They grow well and are the beautiful trees you see along Pinewood View Road and on the corner of Village and Greenwood Parkways by the Hamptons. The beautiful Norway by the main entrance sign started as one of these spruce seedlings, planted about 13 years ago. (Not a bad tree for a buck!)

We recommend you do some research to see which trees will provide the look you want and would grow best where you intend to plant them. Go to "greenwoodohio.org" to find this form online, then click on the name of a tree for more information about that tree.
