#### **Semi-Annual Fee Increase**

The GVCA Board of Trustees has increased the semi-annual fee \$3 a half or \$6 a year starting in July. The amount of the new semi-annual fee, due July 1, will be \$207. The billing will go out in early June, and residents with no prior balance on their account have until July 30 to pay without penalty.

#### **GVCA Semi-Annual Fee\***

The bill for the July 2014 semi-annual fee of \$207 will be mailed in early June. You can mail your check or drop it through the slot in the office door. Alternatively, you can pay the semi-annual fee through your online banking program at your financial institution. Payee = GVCA, 830 Village Club Drive, Sagamore Hills. OH 44067. Include your GVCA account number, so your account is properly credited. Have questions, call 330-467-7036! (\*This is not an optional fee. Also note: There is a \$75 transfer fee on units bought in Greenwood, payable by buyer.) Last day to pay the fee without penalty is July 30, 2014, after which time we will add a late fee of \$40 to all unpaid accounts. An additional late fee of \$20 is added to all unpaid accounts. including unpaid late fees, at the end of each month thereafter. After Sept. 30, all unpaid accounts are turned over to the attorney for collection, who places liens on the properties. All legal fees (such as \$85 for each legal notice sent, and \$250 to place and remove the lien) and court costs are the responsibility of owner and will be added to amount you owe. In addition, use of the facilities will be denied until the account is paid in full.

#### **Renew Your Yearly Guest Passes Now!**

Avoid the frustration of having an expired guest pass when you bring your friends to the pool this summer. Renew your yearly guest pass before it expires and we will add a full year to the current expiration date! One-Year Guest Passes are only \$5 each! (Limit 2 per household.) If you do not buy One-Year Guest Passes ahead of time, or have more guests than passes, you can buy Single Day Guest Passes for \$2 each at the pool pass table. The number of guests per household is limited to 5 at any one time.

#### **Note: Activity Passes Do Not Expire!**

Damaged activity passes are replaced for free when you turn the old one in. Lost activity passes are \$5 to replace.

#### **Activity and Guest Pass Procedure**

To speed up the process and serve you better:

- 1. Fill out the Activity Pass form\* and take to the office during office hours, just like before.
- 2. We'll quickly approve it and make a copy for you.
- 3. Your approved copy is your receipt and also your temporary activity and/or guest pass.
- 4. Your permanent activity pass will be mailed to you.
- 5. The barcode system knows if you have guest passes when we scan your activity pass, so we are no longer issuing the yellow guest pass card.
- 6. Use your copy of your Activity Pass form as a temporary guest pass until the system is updated.

\*Get the form at the GVCA office or on the GVCA website.

#### REMEMBER

Bring your OWN\* Activity Passes! Guests are limited to 5 per household. (\*You can be suspended for up to 30 days for letting someone else use your pass or for arguing with the lifeguards. Be respectful, as lifeguards are the authority at the pool. Thank you!

#### **Pool Rules:**

See the bulletin board or website for complete <u>Pool Rules</u>. Here are a couple of the important points:

#### **Important Pool Rules:**

**Pool breaks** - During pool breaks everyone must exit the pool for the break. Pool breaks are no longer scheduled. Instead they are called at the lifeguard's discretion.

**Personal Flotation Devices** - Only United States Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices may be worn in the pool and the person using them must be supervised by an adult.

**Other Devices** - such as free floating supports (i.e., foam noodles), toys, or swim aids may be used only with permission of the lifeguard on duty. Note: Lifeguards will not approve the use in the pool area of hard balls (such as footballs) that could injure residents.

#### **Deep End Swim Test**

- Anyone who wishes to swim in the deep end may be required by the lifeguard to first perform a swim test.
- The test includes swimming the length of the pool twice using any an aggressive front stroke with face in the water for one length of the pool and any stroke (not the dog paddle) for the second length of the pool, and treading water. Those who pass the test are recorded in our swim test log and permitted to swim in the deep end.
- To ensure every swimmer's safety, we start a new swim test logbook at least twice a year, so please don't be surprised if you are required to take the same swim test again. Safety is our first priority.

#### **ACCES**

#### **ACCES APPROVAL**

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form.

Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. You should have the latest ACCES Rules, dated 4/20/2004, which includes a list of items that do not need approval, as well as a list of what to include with the form, such as a design drawing, a plat map showing location, and color samples.

Single-family homeowners must have their neighbors' signatures on the form. Condominium owners must have the written approval of their board or management company on the "Request for ACCES Approval" form before submission to the ACCES. Condominium associations or their management companies also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have it approved before beginning any outside projects. All requests for approval should be submitted to the GVCA office two weeks prior to the meeting.

The ACCES meets on the first Tuesday of the month. The next ACCES submittal deadline is Tuesday, June 17, 2014. This gives the committee members time to review and do an on-site inspection if necessary. The next ACCES meeting is on Tuesday, July 1, 2014, at 7:00 pm. Approval forms are available on the desk by the women's locker room. If you need a copy, contact the GVCA office or download it from the website. Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning and Summit County building permits for your project!!! Call the Zoning Inspector for Sagamore Hills Township (330-467-0900).

#### **Retractable Awnings - Know the Rules**

A retractable awning for any housing unit in Greenwood (single family home or condominium) requires ACCES Approval. [Homeowners need their neighbors' approval prior to submission to ACCES. Condo owners need their Association's approval prior to submission to ACCES.] The ACCES rules and standards for awnings are very exacting. ACCES recommends you read the retractable awning rules carefully prior to shopping to insure the one you select can meet GVCA's rigorous standards (show supplier the standards). Owners will need a proposal from supplier to submit with your retractable awning Request for Approval form and other supporting / information / materials. Only a few manufacturers meet the strict standards enacted by the GVCA Board of Trustees. For information, go to: http://greenwoodohio.org/retractable awning rules.php

#### **Satellite Antennas**

Satellite antennas, like all changes to your property, are covered by ACCES. If you wish to install a satellite antenna, call the GVCA office and the manager will be glad to come out and help you locate the best place to mount your antenna and will give you an instant ACCES approval. Note: the GVCA Board of Trustees passed a motion in 2001 prohibiting mounting individual satellite antennas on any GVCA or condominium common property, including buildings. Satellite antennas can only be mounted in your exclusive use area, which for condo owners is inside your patio or deck. (Pick up a copy of the ACCES guidelines on satellites from the website or the GVCA Office. Each condominium association is different, so please check with yours for their special rules regarding satellite or cable installation.)

All residents are members of GVCA, which entitles you to use the amenities, such as swimming year-round at our indoor and outdoor pools, fishing in our pond stocked with rainbow trout, bass, bluegill, and channel catfish, playing tennis or volleyball on our outdoor courts, hiking on our trails, and rental of our party rooms. Be sure your title agency notifies GVCA of your pending purchase, so we can let them know about any GVCA fees they need to settle as part of the closing costs. Once you move in, please stop by the GVCA office at the clubhouse to sign up for your activity passes, so you can use the facilities.

#### **Shopping for a Condominium?**

Condominiums associations are required to be fully funded, unless the majority of residents vote against it every year. Fully funded associations typically have higher monthly fees, but should not hit you with special assessments for expected repairs. Check if your association is fully funded before you buy.





