STATE ISSUE 1

To Reduce Penalties for Crimes of Obtaining, Possessing, and Using Illegal Drugs
Proposed Constitutional Amendment

SUMMIT COUNTY

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal and Increase)

A renewal of 2.25 mills and an increase of 1 mill to constitute a tax for the benefit of Summit County to support children services and the care and placement of children by the Summit County Children Services Board at a rate not exceeding 3.25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 32.5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 6 years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

SAGAMORE HILLS TOWNSHIP

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

An additional tax for the benefit of Sagamore Hills Township for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 10 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.

NORDONIA HILLS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

An additional tax for the benefit of the Nordonia Hills City School District for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 6.98 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 69.8 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.
