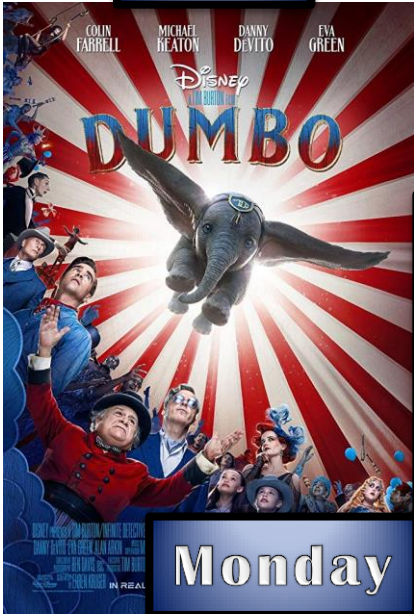

Guest Passes

The daily rate at the pool is now \$3 per guest. Come to the office for your yearly guest passes. It's \$10 for one yearly guest pass or \$20 for two yearly guest passes. We'll add one year to the expiration date of your current guest passes. **Five Year Guest Passes** are available at a reduced rate of **\$40 for 1** or **\$80 for 2**. NOTE: Activity Passes do not expire, but \$5 to replace if lost.

Bring your OWN* Activity Passes! Guests are limited to 5 per household. (*NOTE: You can be suspended for up to 30 days for letting someone else use your pass or arguing with lifeguards.)

Per the GVCA Pool Rules: Gum, alcohol, and glass containers are prohibited in all pool areas. GVCA reserves the right to inspect coolers and containers.

The GVCA Semi-Annual Fee was Due January 1

The GVCA semi-annual fee of \$232 was due January 1, 2020*. GVCA mailed out late fee bills to delinquent residents the last half of January. Make Payee = "GVCA", 830 Village Club Drive, Sagamore Hills, OH 44067. Always include your GVCA account # on your check to ensure proper credit. Mail your check, drop it through the office door, or pay through your own online bill pay program. (PLEASE: To ensure your payment is received, mail or deliver it to the GVCA office, never hand your payment to employees or Board members.)

*NOTE: Last day to pay the fee without penalty was **January 15, 2020**, after which time a late fee of \$30 was added to the account balance and the use of the facilities denied. Additional late fees of \$35 are added to unpaid accounts at the end of every month-end thereafter. **After March 30, unpaid accounts are turned over for collection to the attorney, who places liens on the properties.** All legal fees (such as \$115 for each legal notice sent, and \$270 to place & remove the lien) and court costs are the responsibility of owner and added to amount you owe. Partial payments are applied first to late fees, then to legal fees, and lastly to GVCA semi-annual fees. If the balance owed is not paid in full by the deadlines above, the late & legal fees listed above will be added. For the Collection Policy passed May 21, 2019, see the GVCA website.

ACCES

Check the Greenwood website for the latest ACCES rules. Thank you for helping to keep Greenwood beautiful.

ACCES APPROVAL

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form. Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. The latest ACCES Rules are posted at greenwoodohio.org. **Single-family homeowners** must have their neighbors' signatures on the form.

Condominium owners must have the written approval of their board or management company on the "Request for ACCES Approval" form before submission to the ACCES.

Condominium associations or their management companies also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have it approved before beginning any outside projects.

The ACCES meets on the **first Tuesday of the month**. The next **ACCES submittal deadline is Tuesday, February 25, 2020**. The next ACCES meeting is on **Tuesday, March 3, 2020**, at 7:00 pm in the Garden Room. Approval Forms are at the GVCA office or on the website. **Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning (330-467-0900) and Summit County building permits for your project!!!**

ACCES Suggestions:

ACCES receives many applications for approval. Sometimes we have to disapprove projects, not because there is anything wrong with the project, but because the application is incomplete. To be sure that you receive prompt approval, please follow these guidelines:

- Have the appropriate signatures: for cameras or for single family homes - your neighbors; for condominiums - your condominium board and/or management company.
- Describe the project in detail, the more detail the better.
- Attach the appropriate technical information: company brochures, architect drawings, paint samples, etc. For example, if you are replacing windows, indicate which window is to be replaced, attach a company brochure showing the style and outside color of the window, and have the appropriate signatures. To continue this example, many times we will receive an application that only says "replacing windows" with no supporting information. ACCES cannot approve this application until we receive the supporting information. This causes an unnecessary delay in the completion of your project.

All projects must receive ACCES approval before the project is started. Also be sure to obtain any permits from Sagamore Hills or Summit County, if required.

Send in your ACCES application as soon as you have all the information about your project. Please do not wait until right before you want to start work. (In the summer months, ACCES can receive as many as 50 applications in one month).

By submitting all the information needed, ACCES can approve your application without delay. Thank you.

ACCES (continued)

Satellite Antennas

For instant approval, use the new ACCES Individual Satellite Antenna Authorization Form at the GVCA Office or website under Forms. Fill out completely, initial, and sign that you will comply, and it's instantly approved when dropped at the GVCA Office.

Dog Rules - Per ACCES and Summit County:

Residents are required to clean up and properly dispose of their pet's waste throughout maintained areas of Greenwood Village. Do not let dogs spray delicate plants. Do not leave barking dogs outside where they will create a nuisance. Also, Summit County ordinances require you to license your dog, physically confine or restrain your dog when on your property, and always leash your dog when not on your property. (*Condominium residents, that means anywhere outside your unit.*) If any resident has a problem with a dog, the number to call is 330-643-2845 for the Summit County Dog Warden.

NOTICE: Be sure your realtor knows Greenwood bylaws do not allow posting of unapproved signs. One 11 x 14 inch "For Sale" sign is permitted in the window. Contact the GVCA office if you are having an open house. The GVCA Board has approved Greenwood "Open House" signs that you or your realtor may rent at the office for no charge. (\$40 deposit required per sign).

Thinking of Buying?

Your title agency must notify GVCA of your pending purchase and settle any outstanding GVCA fees as part of the closing costs, as well as any outstanding condominium fees if you are not buying a single family home where you own the lot. Once you move in, please stop by the GVCA office in the clubhouse to sign up for your activity passes, so you can use the facilities, such as the indoor and outdoor pools, sauna, tennis courts, fishing lake, or rent a party room for your event.
