President's Corner (continued)

Greenwood Village's Board of Directors met and approved a new 30-year reserve study done for GVCA by Reserve Advisors. The initial reserve study was mostly completed back in March. By obtaining actual quotes for several of the largest projects, removing non-essential projects, and reducing the scope of others, we were able to work with Reserve Advisors to lower the 30-year total capital expenses from \$5.2 million down to \$4.1 million. This means with our current reserves, along with a modest fee increase each year, GVCA will continue fully funding our reserves to meet anticipated capital expenses.

Fully funding GVCA's reserves means the clubhouse, pools, and other amenities will be well maintained into the future. It also makes your home more valuable, as many banks now require homeowner associations to be fully funding as a condition of a home loan.

This month we are replacing the large HVAC unit mounted on the roof of the clubhouse. We are taking advantage of this opportunity to make improvements to the skylights and repairs to the roof as well. If you see a big crane at the clubhouse, now you know why.

While I cannot address every issue, update and concern in this monthly communication, I will look forward to listening to your ideas on making Greenwood Village the best community possible. Please do not hesitate to reach out to me at GVCAPresident@gmail.com or 330-655-5566

Note: Activity Passes Do Not Expire!

Damaged activity passes are replaced for free when you turn the old one in. Lost activity passes are \$5 each to replace.

Avoid the rush and renew your guest passes now, or any time you are up by the GVCA office. They do not have to be expired, we will add a year to your current expiration date. Come to the GVCA Office to complete the form. We do not issue activity or guest passes from our billing statements or over the phone. Contact the GVCA office if you are having an open house. The GVCA Board has approved Greenwood "Open House" signs that you or your realtor may rent at the office for no charge. (\$40 deposit required per sign).

Greenwood Village is one of the most unique developments in Ohio. Surrounded by parks, it is a nature lover's paradise. Fire/EMS Open House

Saturday, October 8, from 11:00 am - 1:30 pm Sagamore Hills Township will be hosting an Open House & Dedication for our Fire/EMS Division 2220 located in the Sagamore Hills Township Park at 11550 Valley View Rd., Bldg. A. Everyone is welcome to walk through to view the newly renovated Fire/EMS Sub-station that will be serviced by Macedonia Fire/EMS.

Dump Your Junk Day

Sagamore Hills Township will be hosting a "Dump Your Junk" day **Saturday, October 15th 9:00 am - 1:00 pm** at 11551 Valley View Rd. for Sagamore Hills Township residents ONLY! (Must show proof of residency - NO HAZARDOUS WASTE!) They will be accepting the following items:

•Household items (including large and small appliances and furniture) •Construction debris and yard waste

•All mattresses, box springs and upholstered furniture must be wrapped in plastic

*Reminder from Sagamore Hills Township:

All residential sales must be registered at the Township Office. No more than 2 sales are permitted at a residence in a calendar year. Sale duration shall not exceed 3 days and signs cannot obstruct driver sight lines or be posted on utility poles. Residential Sales include, garage, yard, barn, estate, tag, etc. Also, all roofing jobs must be registered with the Township.

GVCA Semi-Annual Fee was due July 1*

The July 2016 semi-annual fee of \$217 was due July 1, 2016. Mail your check or drop it through the slot in the office door. Alternatively, pay the semi-annual fee through your online banking program at your financial institution. Payee = "GVCA", 830 Village Club Drive, Sagamore Hills, OH 44067. Include your GVCA account number on your check, so your account is properly credited.

(Please do not hand your payment to employees or board members.) (*This is not an optional fee. Also note: There is a \$100 transfer fee on units bought in Greenwood, payable by buyer. Last day to pay the fee without penalty was July 30, 2016, after which time we add a late fee of \$60 to all unpaid accounts. In addition, use of the facilities will be denied until account is paid in full. An additional late fee of \$30 is added to all unpaid accounts, including unpaid late fees, at the end of each month thereafter. (Note the new Late Fee amounts.)

After September 30, all unpaid accounts are turned over to the attorney for collection, who places liens on the properties. All legal fees (such as \$95 for each legal notice sent, and \$250 to place and remove the lien) and court costs are the responsibility of the owner and will be added to amount you owe.

ACC/ACCES

A Friendly Reminder from the ACCES

Please remember **all changes**, improvements, additions, landscaping, etc., to the outside of an existing home or condominium unit **must have ACCES approval** <u>before the project starts</u>.

Mailboxes – Please Inspect for Compliance

Mailboxes get taken for granted, but are the first thing potential buyers notice when they drive into a development. Please inspect your mailbox and make sure it is in good repair. If not, now is the perfect time of year to do some maintenance, give it a coat of stain/paint, or buy a new one.

Mailboxes are required to have a newspaper slot. This slot is necessary for us to deliver the Greenwood newsletter as well as other important information to residents. It is illegal for us to deliver directly into the mailbox. Please refer to the revised ACCES mailbox rules posted on the Greenwood website

ACCES APPROVAL

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form. Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. You should have the latest ACCES Rules, dated 4/20/2004, which includes a list of items that do not need approval, as well as a list of what to include with the form, such as a design drawing, a plat map showing location, and color samples. Single-family homeowners must have their neighbors' signatures on the form. Condominium owners must have the written approval of their board or management company on the "Request for ACCES Approval" form before submission to the ACCES. Condominium associations or their management companies also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have it approved before beginning any outside projects. All requests for approval should be submitted to the GVCA office two weeks prior to the meeting. The ACCES meets on the first Tuesday of the month. The next ACCES submittal deadline is Tuesday, September 27, 2016. This gives the committee members time to review and do an on-site inspection if necessary. The next ACCES meeting is on Tuesday, October 4, 2016, at 7:00 pm. Approval forms are available on the desk by the women's locker room. If you need a copy, contact the GVCA office or download it from the website. Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning and Summit County building permits for your project !!! Call the Zoning Inspector for Sagamore Hills Township (330-467-0900).

Retractable Awnings - Know the Rules

A retractable awning for any housing unit in Greenwood (single family home or condominium) requires ACCES Approval. [Homeowners need their neighbors' approval prior to submission to ACCES. Condo owners need their Association's approval prior to submission to ACCES.] The ACCES rules and standards for awnings are very exacting. ACCES recommends you read the retractable awning rules carefully prior to shopping to insure the one you select can meet GVCA's rigorous standards (show the supplier the standards). Owners will need a proposal from a supplier to submit with your retractable awning Request for Approval form and other supporting / information / materials. Only a few manufacturers meet the strict standards enacted by the GVCA Board of Trustees. For info go to: http://greenwoodohio.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/04/Retractable_-Awnings Rules.pdf

Fire Safety

Please be safe when you cook outside! DO NOT USE your grill* within 10 feet of your house, car, deck, garage, or anything else combustible.

Permanent outdoor grills, fire pits, and fireplaces require ACCES Approval. Fire pits must be 25 feet away from all combustible structures. Burning of leaves and yard waste is not permitted.

"In accordance with the Ohio Fire Code, charcoal burners, gas grills or any other type of open-flame devices* are prohibited to be used within (10) feet of a multi-family building (including the attached garage). The Ohio Fire Code also prohibits operation of such devices on balconies and decks. Violations of this Fire Code should be reported to the local Fire Department at the non-emergency phone number of 330-467-7410."

*Includes Tiki Torches, Candles, Chimineas, Kerosene Heaters, or anything else that burns!

Garage Sales, Estate Sales, and Other Personal Events*:

Reminder: Only one sign is allowed for personal events such as a garage sale or house party, only on the lot of the residence where the event is taking place, and only on the day of the event. If the residence is on condominium property, the permission of the condominium association may be required. If the event is an open house, ACCES approved "Open House" signs must be used, which you or your realtor may rent at the GVCA office for no charge. (\$40 deposit required per sign). All other signs are prohibited unless approved by ACCES.

Revised ACCES Rules Now on the Greenwood Website

Satellite Antennas - New Authorization Form

Reminder to Dog Walkers


