Please Note: Vacate pool <u>15 min. prior</u> to closing time. Locker rooms/pool area to be vacated <u>by</u> closing times.

REMEMBER: Bring your OWN* Activity Pass! (*WARNING: Up to a 30-day suspension for letting someone else use your pass or for arguing with lifeguards.)

Guest Passes

The daily guest rate at the pool is \$3 cash.

One Year Guest Passes are \$10 for 1 or \$20 for 2.

Five Year Guest Passes are available at a reduced rate of \$40 for 1 or \$80 for 2. NOTE: Activity Passes do not expire, but are \$5 to replace, if lost.

ACCES

ACCES meets the first Tuesday of every month.

Applications must be submitted no later than the week before. Please attach all supporting documentation, such as brochures, color samples, drawings, etc.

Lights, Cameras, Approval!

Lights* and doorbell cameras need ACCES approval. See the <u>lights and cameras rules</u> posted on the website to ensure you buy the correct type of light, mount your camera properly and supply all the information needed for ACCES approval.

*Light color must be ≤ 3,000° K.

Mailboxes

As guests and potential buyers drive through Greenwood, our mailboxes are the first thing visitors notice, especially if rusted or falling apart. Please make sure your mailbox is in good condition, with the wood stained and the metal painted. Or install a new mailbox from one of the mailbox designs pre-approved by ACCES. Please help Greenwood stay beautiful.

ACCES APPROVAL

Don't forget to submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form. Additions or outside changes to existing lots or structures must be submitted in writing to Greenwood's Architectural Control Committee for Existing Structures (ACCES) for approval. See latest ACCES Rules at www.greenwoodohio.org.

<u>Condominium associations or their management companies</u> also must submit a "Request for ACCES Approval" form to the ACCES and have ACCES approval before beginning any outside projects.

<u>Don't forget Sagamore Hills zoning (330-467-0900) & Summit County building permits for your project!!!</u>

Tips to Insure an ACCES Application is Approved:

- 1. All applications must have approval signatures (from neighbors if you own a single family home, or from your condominium board or management company if you own a condominium) before submission to the ACCES.
- 2. Applications for tree removal: Trees must be marked with a ribbon.
- 3. Supporting documents must be included, e.g., if requesting new windows, attach the brochure from the company and circle the style and color of the window exterior. Include supporting construction documents if applicable. Links to websites are not acceptable.
- 4. The more information provided, the more likely the application will be approved on the first submittal. Most applications are disapproved only because not enough information was provided.

Tree Replacements:

Each year 40+ requests for tree removals are reviewed and dispositioned by ACCES. GVCA and ACCES want to maintain the number of trees in Greenwood Village. Residents or condominium associations are required to plant a new 4' tall tree on their property for each removed. To track these replacements, approvals now require replacement tree(s) be planted within 180 days. Photo(s) of new tree(s) with diagram showing location of the tree(s) must be submitted. You can request extensions. Submittals requesting tree removals should clearly identify the trees with a ribbon tied around them. (No permanent markings are allowed, in case tree removal is not approved).

Other Reminders

Applications must be submitted by the owner or the condominium association (if a condominium project). ACCES does not accept applications directly from contractors, nor does ACCES respond to calls or emails from contractors asking if an application has been approved. ACCES reviews projects as submitted via e-mail to gvca_office@yahoo.com. Approval Forms are on the www.greenwoodohio.org. Submit your outdoor project early so it is not delayed.

ACCES (Continued)

Dog Rules - Per ACCES and Summit County:

Residents are required to clean up and properly dispose of their pet's waste throughout maintained areas of Greenwood Village. Do not let dogs spray delicate plants. Do not leave barking dogs outside where they will create a nuisance. Also, Summit County ordinances require you to license your dog, physically confine or restrain your dog when on your property, and always leash your dog when not on your property. (Condominium residents, that means anywhere outside.) If any resident has a problem with a dog, the number to call is 330-643-2845 for the Summit County Dog Warden. Dogs using an invisible fence need ACCES Approval.

Ohio law requires that dog licenses are to be **renewed from December 1 through January 31** or within thirty days if you acquire a new dog. Puppies must be licensed by the time they reach three months of age. Cost is \$18 annually for a one-year dog license, \$54 for a three-year dog license, and \$180 for lifetime/permanent dog license. Ohio law requires an additional late fee (\$18 in Summit County) if you do not renew your dog's license by January 31 of the year it is due. Go to the <u>Summit County Dog Licensing Website</u>, or go to the License Bureau in Northfield Village to license your dog.

Satellite Antennas

For instant approval, use the ACCES Individual Satellite Antenna Authorization Form at the GVCA Office or website under Forms. Fill out completely, initial, and sign that you will comply, and it's instantly approved when dropped at the GVCA Office. Click here for Satellite Instant Approval Form & Rules.

GREENWOOD NEWS (Continued)

Greenwood encourages residents to buy dark-sky compliant lighting for easy ACCES approval, and

more importantly, be light friendly to your neighbors and wildlife in how you use your lighting. Take the online DarkSky Home Lighting Assessment quiz and learn how you can light the areas that matter when lighting is needed, while preserving the night sky, reducing your electric bill, and being a good





neighbor by not letting your lights shine in their windows. Lights are meant for safety, but can be dangerous if their glare blinds a driver to someone walking. With the leaves off the trees, now is a perfect time to do a lighting assessment before buying new light fixtures or light bulbs. Link is on the website.
